CONFIRMATION

REFUND POLICY/CANCELLATIONS

A full refund will be given to an applicant if your application is received after the camp has reached the enrollment limit. Early cancellation due to a medical excuse will receive a full refund, minus a \$25 cancellation fee, if the cancellation is made in writing, prior to the start of camp and accompanied by a physician's statement. A camper departing camp due to an injury received at camp will receive a prorated refund, minus a \$25 cancellation fee. All other cancellations will receive payment back, minus a \$50 cancelation fee, if notification is made at least one week prior to the start of camp. NO refunds will be given for no-shows or campers sent home for disciplinary reasons. Allow up to four weeks for refunding processing.

INSURANCE

Campers are required to have their own health insurance policy. Health and medical authorization forms will be emailed to you with your confirmation packet. A physical is not required for these camps.
